<b>Sample (for standardization and norms)</b>	Sample for initial adaptation was from a single representative school, Pune city (N = 260 boys ) from std. VII to XI For revised version : 6 different schools in different parts of Pune city, total boys (N – 1696), Girls (N- 1447) from std. V, VII and IX
<b>Reliability</b>	Revised version : test-retest correlation 0.55
<b>Validity</b>	For Revised version Concurrent validity : correlated with Shaleya Jeevan Prashnavali – a school inventory and Vyaktitva Shodhika - a personality inventory. correlation with school adjustment (Shaleya Jeevan Prashnavali) : 0.57 (boys) and 0.52 (girls) correlation with Neurotic Tendency : -0.33 (boys) and -0.34 (girls) correlation with Mental Health : 0.36 (boys) and 0.40 (girls) Construct Validity : A factorial analysis was done with an eight-factor solution. The second factor that emerged accounted for 11% of the variance and was named as 'Emotional Maturity and Adjustment'. The details are available in the manual.

<b>Standardization category</b>	Standardized

<b>More about the test</b>	This test is based on Bell's Home Inventory. The adapted version contains 60 items. Initial adaptation was done for doctoral research in which it was used to study adaptation of highly intelligent and highly creative student. The test was in continued use in many other researches at JPIP.
