Item type	Multiple choice
Kind of Response	Reading the passage and choosing the correct alternatives
Areas	Three areas home, school, entertainment and two sub-areas in each (a) understanding a problem, (b) making a decision. So total six areas.
Time	Total 1 hr. approximately. 12 mins. for each set with appropriate intervals if essential
Scoring procedure	Manual scoring.
Statistics studied while standardizing the test	
Sample (for standardization and norms)	N = 425 students from grade VIII
Reliability	Internal consistency - parallel form
Validity	Correlated with intelligence, home and school adjustment and personality inventories. Construct validity established. (Refer to the thesis)
Norms	Means and standard deviations available. (Refer to the thesis)
Standardization category	Standardized
More about the test	Two parallel forms have been produced selecting 48 items from the original version. Each form contains 24 items to be administered as a single set in a single session. Can be used as pretest-posttest.
