About the course :

P. G. Diploma in School Psychology has recognition of the Pune University. JPIP is running this course since 1993. This course is available at very few places in India

The Post Graduate Diploma in School Psychology course is formulated keeping in view the needs of school teachers, researchers, counsellors and social workers. The course is also supported by extensive theoretical and applied research done by JPIP during the last 50 years. Since 1993, nineteen batches of School Psychologists have completed the course and the alumni have significantly contributed to the fields of educational and counselling psychology.

Aim :

The course leads to develop the students to perform the role of counsellor who can link the school, parents and teachers for wholesome development and effective adjustment of students in the school.

Structure :

The course consists of four papers for which theory and practical work go hand in hand. The specific titles of the courses are

1. Paper I : Development and Adjustment in Childhood and Adolescence
2. Paper II : Psychology of Human Abilities
3. Paper III : Principles and Procedure of Educational Guidance and Counselling
4. Paper IV : Psychological and Educational Measurement and Evaluation
5. Paper V : Practical

The Practical work incorporated in each paper consists of class observation, preparing checklists, administration of some psychological tests to individuals and groups, interpretation of scores, writing testing test reports, conducting group and individual guidance sessions for the students, field visits, film week etc .

Eligibility :

Rules of eligibility for this diploma are as follows (preference as per the descending sequence)

- Candidate having in B.A/B.Sc. (Psychology) and Home Science (Child development) will be given first preference for admission followed by -
- B.A/B.Sc. with general Psychology, B. Ed. or completion of three courses in Psychology in any recognized open various University. , BA.M.S., B.H.M.S., M.B.B.S.
- Any graduate with 2 years of experience of working with children at an organizational level.
- Any graduate who wishes to work in school setup/ for school age population with a minimum of 60% marks at graduation

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
