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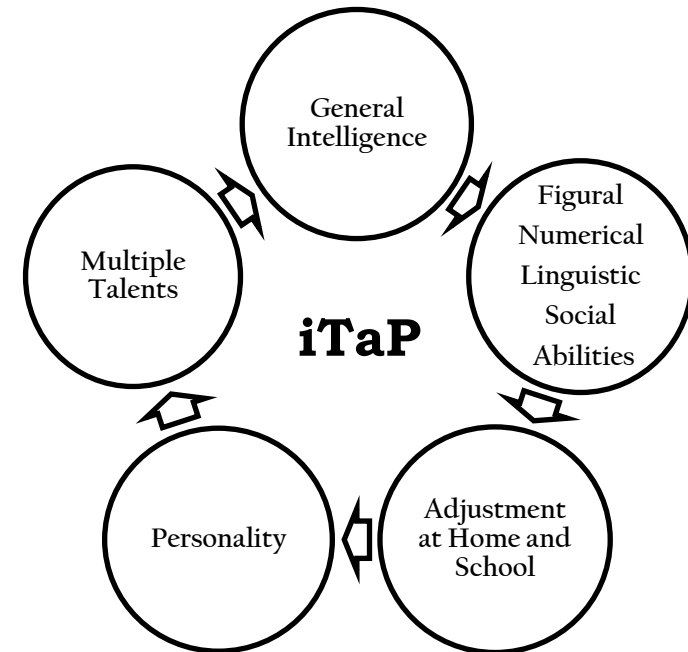

## “What is iTap?”

The *iTaP* (*intelligence, talent, adjustment & personality*) is a battery of selected standardized psychological tests. It informs the parents regarding the child’s strengths and weaknesses.

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### ~ Special Features ~

- ♣ This test is designed for standards 5<sup>th</sup> through 9<sup>th</sup>.  
(It is more beneficial that students in Std 5 appear after their first school term is over)  
(It is more beneficial that students in Std 9 appear before their first school term is over)
- ♣ It informs the parents regarding the child’s General Intelligence level, figural, numerical, linguistic and social abilities, adjustment levels and some personality components.
- ♣ This is a group test.

### ~ About the Test ~



- ♣ This is a paper-pencil test.
- ♣ Pre-registration is necessary.
- ♣ The child should carry 2 sharp pencils, a snack box and a water bottle while coming for the test.
- ♣ This test can be solved in English or Marathi.
- ♣ The iTaP is different from schoolwork, so it becomes interesting for the students.
- ♣ The whole test needs around 3 1/2 hours.
- ♣ NO preparation is required for this test.
- ♣ The interpretation of scores is based on the child’s standard, age and gender.
- ♣ The test report is sent to the parents by email, 3 weeks after the test date.
- ♣ This detailed report contains the child’s strengths and how they can be used and how the weaknesses can be improved, along with suggestions.
- ♣ Aptitude testing and Career Guidance is done AFTER the child appears for Std.10 examination.
