- Item type: Multiple choice, completion, variety of content, item forms and response types, wider sampling of abilities, interesting tasks
- Training is mandatory
- Language: English, Marathi, Tamil, Hindi & Gujrathi

Mental Ability


- Measures the factors namely Understanding, Reasoning & Evaluation
- A Battery of nine subtests
- Comprises of figures
- Nonverbal test of Intelligence
- Language: English & Marathi

Numerical Ability

- Measures the factors namely understanding of basic numerical concepts.
- A battery of seven sub tests.
- Comprises of numbers, test contains questions along with some numerical information.
- Language: English & Marathi



Mathematical Ability Test


- Measures the factors like conceptual clarity in mathematics, verbal mathematics, and creative thinking in mathematics.
- Based on school syllabus for respective standards.
- Consists of 20 questions.
- Language: English & Marathi.

Scholastic Ability Test

- Measures speed and accuracy of perception, sequencing and counting, dealing with symbolic information, concept formation, writing readiness, word meaning, problem solving and language usage.
- A battery of twenty one subtests.
- Item type: verbal, nonverbal and numerical problems.
- Language : Marathi.


Emotional Intelligence Test (How Do I Feel?)

- Measures four important factors, Emotional Perception, Emotional Assimilation, Emotional Understanding, and Emotional Management. The test is based on Ability model of Emotional Intelligence by Mayer and Salovey
- A battery of four subtests
- Item type: open-ended and multiple-choice questions in verbal, pictorial form
- Language : English & Marathi

Tests of Social Behavioural Reasoning

- Measures the ability to recognize or understand a person's inner feelings, emotions, thoughts, purpose, intentions, desires, needs or sensations and arrive at the right decision, using all available behavioural information
- A battery of four subtests.
- Item type: open-ended and multiple-choice items in verbal and pictorial form.
- Language: English & Marathi.

Tests of Social Behavioral Memory


- Measures the ability to remember a person's feelings, emotions and Behaviour in a social context.
- A battery of two subtests.
- Item type: pictorial, forced-choice items.

Social Behavioral Creativity Test

- Measures the ability to produce many or unusual ideas using behavioral information.
 It helps to find out various ways to get into or out of social situations.
- A battery of two subtests
- Item type: open-ended, verbal and pictorial form
- Language : English & Marathi

Home Adjustment Inventory

- · Measures adjustment: adaptation with the home environment
- A battery of 60 items
- Item type: multiple choice, forced choice verbal tests
- Language : English & Marathi







Marital Satisfaction Scale

- Measures factors like sexual satisfaction, emotional bonding, sharing
 household responsibilities, views towards child rearing, personality
 of the spouse, motivating each other, religious beliefs, growing in and
 with the relationship, time devoted to each other, sharing thoughts,
 economic stability, relations with in laws, general marital satisfaction
- There are four forms of this test:
 - 1] M.S.S. (Full form)
 - 2] M.S.S. (abbreviated versions A & B)
 - 3] M.S.S. (for couples with infertility)
 - 4] Expectations from married life (EML)

For forms 1 to 3 : 22 years & above (married individual)

For form 4:18 years & above

Tests of Sexuality Measures

- Measures understanding, knowledge, type of attitude and how the gender stereotypes emerge in adolescence
- A battery of three subtests- stepping into youth: knowledge test (SYKT), stepping into youth attitude scale (SYAT) and stepping into youth gender concepts test (SYGC). Each subtest has covered varied sub areas
- Item type: verbal test of knowledge, attitude and gender concepts related to sexuality
- Language: English & Marathi











Achievement Motivation Scale

- Measures achievement motivation of students. It consists of items on perseverance, emotional states, independence, involvement, overcoming obstacles, attribution style, goal setting and achievement-related thoughts.
- Self-report, Likert scale.
- Paper pencil and computerized.
- Language: English & Marathi.



1	School Climate Assessment for eNhancement (SCAN)	School Climate Assessment is a scientific assessment to understand school as a whole. This battery collected responses from several stakeholders and provides a comprehensive picture of the school climate on four dimensions and also measures five areas of students' development. Evaluation of the existing school climate and school enrichment program can be designed after SCAN.	English and Marathi	2 days	Schools
2	Mind Search	It is a mental health screening tool that measures an individual's mental health. It provides a more nuanced understanding of an individual's mental health concerns.	English and Marathi	20-25 min.	Adult
3	Family Culture Inventory	It measures family culture, consists of 65 items, and assesses five domains, transactional, Emotional, System, Growth and Community domain.	English and Marathi	45 min.	Above (13 years)

7	iA-Intelligence and Aptitude Measurement	iA test is designed with a specific purpose of guiding students to choose an appropriate career after 10th,11th & 12th grades. 8	iTap-Intelligence, Adjustment and Personality Test	It measures student's general intelligence, three abilities, five personality dimensions, Home and School Adjustment. 9	BEAM-Battery of Entrepreneurial Aptitude Measurement	BEAM test is scientifically assessing the potential of the candidates suitable for Entrepreneurship.
