



## CBC Sadhana Saptah

CBC Sadhana Saptah, a week-long capacity-building initiative was organized by Capacity Building Commission (CBC) and Karmayogi Bharat from April 2 to April 8. This event convened over 200 senior government authorities from central and state levels for a focused exercise to enhance governance capabilities. The central theme, "Technology, Tradition & Tangible Outcome" guided discussions on modernizing the civil service for the Viksit

Bharat 2047 vision. This event was attended on 2nd April by Dr. Dhanshree Sowni, Academics Department Head of Jnana Prabodhini's Institute of Psychology.

Key Highlights of the event:

- **High-Level Vision:** The Prime Minister's message called for governance to evolve with the times, emphasizing "Naagrik Devo Bhava," data-driven decisions, and a duty-oriented public service.
- **Strategic Shift:** Chief Secretary to the PM, Dr. P.K. Mishra, chaired the inaugural session, highlighting the imperative to move from rule-based to role-based governance. He stressed that new capabilities are needed to tackle technological disruption, climate change, and global uncertainties, with continuous learning being crucial for innovation and empathy.
- **Entrepreneurial State:** A masterclass by the Chief Economic Advisor, Shri V. Anantha Nageswaran, proposed a shift from a process-driven bureaucracy to a risk-taking, outcome-focused governance model. Key recommendations included leveraging AI for employability and fostering institutional learning.
- **Future-Ready Training:** A National Workshop presented recommendations from four task forces on creating future-ready training institutions, focusing on networking, AI, cybersecurity, and enhancing participatory decision-making.
